Doing well in any online class is not easy; especially not ones taught by Dr. D. However, with **HARD WORK** and **DILIGENCE** it is achievable.

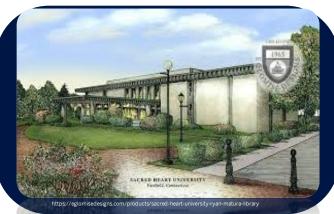

It is important that she instills this trait of including citations in her students because in the career world citations are always necessary.

The syllabus is a break down for the whole semester. This document includes due dates/times, and assignments. The due dates are laid out far in advance, so late work is really unacceptable.
